December 15, 1919 - February 12, 2010

Alex Kulin, Jr., 90, of Butler, formerly of East Butler, died at 11:10 AM on Friday, February 12, 2010 at his residence.

He was born December 15, 1919 in East Butler, PA, the son of the late Alex Kulin, Sr. and Julia Susina Kulin.

Alex attended Cornerstone Baptist Church. He loved hunting, fishing and camping. He was a member of the NRA, East Butler Hunting & Fishing Club, Hunting & Fishing Club of Ludlow, PA, North American Hunter's Club and North American Fishermen Club.

He had worked at the Bantam during World War II where he made torpedo engines, shell casings and later stainless steel trailers. He retired from Armco Steel after 35 years of service as a strip shearer and welder. He received a heroism award from Butler County for saving two people by pulling them out of the East Brady River.

Surviving are his wife, E. Marie (Miller) Kulin whom he married November 3, 1941; 3 daughters, Mrs. Richard (Ruth) Lynn of Arizona, Mrs. Jack (Gloria) Sabatelli of Butler and Mrs. Jim (Edie) Buss of Connoquenessing; 2 sons, Alex "Ark" Kulin, III and his wife, Joanna of East Butler and Ronald Kulin & his wife, Anne of Corry; 11 grandchildren, 10 great grandchildren and his brother,

Mike Kulin and his wife, Fran of Kentucky.

He was preceded in death by a grandson, 2 sisters and 2 brothers.
