Betty Margaret Huselton, 82, of Butler passed away, Sunday, May 3, 2009 at Magee Women's Hospital in Pittsburgh.

She was born April 18, 1927 in Penn Township, the daughter of the late E.Dale Hamilton and the late Florence B. Brown Hamilton. She was a direct descendant of Robert Brown, the first settler of Penn Township in 1796-7.
