Boyd William Fulk, Jr., 90, of Butler, PA, passed away Wednesday, February 15, 2012 at Newhaven Court.

He was born October 30, 1921 in Marienville, PA, the son of the late Boyd Wm. Fulk, Sr. and Gladys (Baker) Fulk.

Boyd was a 1939 graduate of St. Petersburg, PA High School. He served during WWII in the Army 7th Division, 57th Field Artillery in the Pacific Theatre. Boyd retired in 1983 after 43 years of service with the Baltimore & Ohio Railroad. He was a member of St. Peter's Anglican Church where he served in the vestry and was an usher. He was also a member and Past Commander of the American Legion Post #636 of Foxburg, Coudersports Consistory, Canby Lodge of St. Petersburg, VFW in Parker, NRA, E.
