

## Carl "Peck" Wise

February 5, 1941 - June 17, 2014

Carl "Peck" Wise, 73, of Butler, passed away Tuesday, June 17, 2014 at his home.

He was born February 5, 1941 in Jefferson Twp., PA, son of the late William C. and Mildred (Knause) Wise.

Peck retired from HP Starr as a sales manager after 37 years of service. He was a member of Jefferson Center Church, F.A.M. Armstrong Lodge #239, New Castle Consistory, Syria Shrine, past President of Saxonburg Volunteer Fire Company and was the Saxonburg Carnival Chairman for 30 years. He was also a veteran of the US Army National Guard.

He had spent endless hours raising money for the Shriners Children Hospitals and was very passionate about helping children. Thus he became known as the "King of the Raffle". All who knew him, knew of his big heart. He loved people in general and loved to talk to anyone he met.


