



Cpt. Charles E. Calahan

January 6, 1928 - August 29, 2022

On Monday August 29, 2022, Cpt. Charles E. Calahan, USA/Ret., formerly of Center Township, died in Tyler, Texas from injuries sustained from a car accident.

He was born January 6, 1928 in Green Tree, PA, the son of the late Elmer Ellsworth and Bernice (Bennington) Calahan.

Charles was preceded in death by his wife, Gilda in 2009 and two brothers; Bradley and Howard. He is survived by his sister, Penny Transue of Kingman, AZ and one son and two daughters. 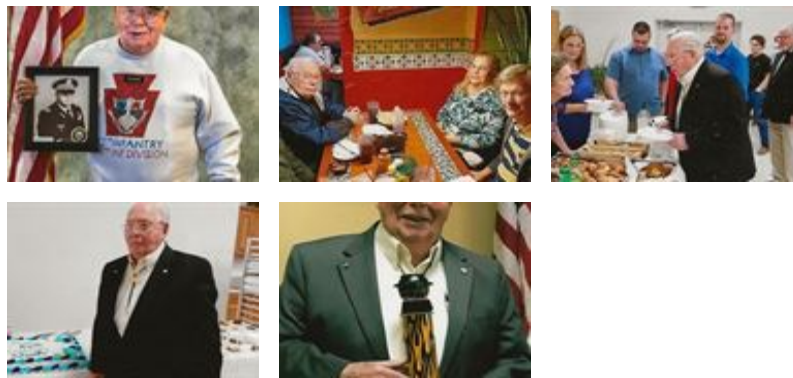
