Charles B. Rickenbrode, 80, of Butler, PA, passed away Tuesday, September 3, 2013 at Butler Veteran's Affairs Medical Center.

He was born January 4, 1933 in Niles, OH, the son of the late Charles L. and Catherine (Easley) Rickenbrode Geagan.

Charles was a graduate of Bruin High School and was a veteran of the US Air Force. Charles was trained in the United States Air Force as an aircraft engine specialist, earned a National Defense Service Medal and Good Conduct Medal, and was honorable discharged in June of 1955.
