Clair W. Gardner, 85, of Slippery Rock, PA, passed away at 6:20 AM on Tuesday, October 9, 2012 at Allegheny General Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA.

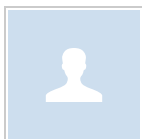
