Clay was a veteran of the U.S. Army where he served as an infantry combat soldier from 2009-2012 in Operation Iraqi Freedom where he received many medals and honors including Iraqi campaign medal with 2 stars, a national defense service medal, a global war on terrorism service medal, and his sharpshooter marksmanship badge. His last duty assignment was in the Wounded Warriors in Schofield Barracks, HI.

Clay is survived by his parents Dean "Butch" Fredley and Richelle Fredley, his sister Chloe Fredley, his nephew and niece Hudson and Harrison who he adored spending time with.

He was preceded in death by both maternal and paternal grandparents and uncle.
