Daniel Ray Rose, 92, of Cabot, passed away Saturday, February 15, 2014.

He was born June 15, 1921 in Everett, PA, the son of the late Daniel D. and Zella (Blankley) Rose.

Dan was a U.S. Army Veteran serving during WWII and the Korean War as a Sgt. 1st Class. He was awarded a Purple Heart among other honor metals. 
