Dolores Marie (Dolly) Allison passed away on Thanksgiving morning, November 28, 2024. She was born May 16, 1928, in Pittsburgh, PA and was the daughter of the late Argel G. and Edna A. (Broda) Boggess.

Dolores was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church of Butler for over 65 years. During that time, she taught Sunday school, vacation bible school, was a member of the alter guild, women's bible study, and church counsel, serving as an outreach chairperson.
