Dolores (Dode) Barclay Pizor, age 81, died Aug 14, 2015 after a three year courageous struggle with aggressive breast cancer.

Dode was born April 4, 1934 in Vandergrift, the daughter of the late Clyde Ralph and Gladys (Miller) Barclay.

Dode was a lover of people, a fierce advocate for those who are intellectually challenged (past President of Butler ARC) and a Past Worthy Matron and District Deputy of The Order of the Eastern Star #45.
