Doris Mae (White) Henderson, 90, of Butler, passed away following a brief illness on Saturday, May 4, 2024, at Butler Memorial Hospital.

Born March 27, 1934, in Butler, she was the daughter of William Howard "Muck" White and Ruth Naomi (Robinson) White.

Doris was a homemaker and also worked as a part-time cleaner for various private homes and employers, including Commercial Credit and The Rusty Nail.
