Eleanor always made time for each of her 4 grandchildren. They were her world. She left them with a lifetime of memories, and will live forever in their hearts, and through the many stories they share and will share with their children and grandchildren.

Eleanor touched numerous lives and left a unique and lasting impression- usually mixed with so much laughter. She was known for her high pitched, crazy, contagious laughter, which we will miss.

She leaves behind her loving and devoted husband of almost 40 years, Francis 'Joe' Spohn. They were wed on October 18, 1980.

She will also be forever remembered by her 3 children: James (Karen) Huselton, Deborah (James) Dyer, and Tracy Huselton.

To her 4 grandchildren Grama walked on water. She will be eternally loved by Tyler, Christopher, Jessica and Lexie, who now have their own special angel in heaven to help guide their lives.
