Esther I. Campbell, 90, of North Washington, PA, died Thursday, September 2, 2004 at her daughter's residence in Youngstown, OH.

She was born Wednesday, September 17, 1913 in Walley's Mills, Parker Twp., Butler Co., the daughter of the late Arthur Walley and the late Blanche (Miller) Walley.

She was the longest member of the North Washington United Presbyterian Church having been a member for 72 years.
