



## Francis "Frank" Joseph McNeill Jr.

October 26, 1940 - March 14, 2023

Francis 'Frank' Joseph McNeill Jr. was born on October 26, 1940 in Peoria, Illinois and died on March 14, 2023 at the Veterans' Hospital in Butler, Pennsylvania. He passed away surrounded by family at the age of 82.

Frank was a loving husband, father, and grandfather. He was preceded in death by his parents Francis Joseph McNeill, Sr. and Harriet Louise (Faye) McNeill, and brother Michael Dennis McNeill, all of Denver, Colorado. Frank is survived by his wife of 59 years Patricia "Pat" Elaine Webb, daughter Deborah Lohrbach (Mark), sons Gerald McNeill (Cheryl), Christopher McNeill (Tammy), Anthony McNeill (Angela), and Michael McNeill (Shala), sisters Terry Andrews, Peggy Nemmers, Pat Grove, and many grand and great-grandchildren.

Frank was baptized in November 1940 at St. Monica's Church in Peoria, IL, but moved to Denver, CO with his parents in 1947. Frank served with the U.S. Naval Reserves from April 1958 through December 1959. He then served in the U.S. Navy on active duty from December 1959 to December 1979 and his time in the services included tours of duty during the Vietnam War. Frank retired from active duty on December 8, 1979.

Besides his commitment to the military, Frank was an avid world traveler, including RV travel with family through much of the United States. He enjoyed

genealogy and was particularly fond of assembling toy models. Frank was well-known for his wit and storytelling and will be very missed.

An interment with Military Honors was held on Monday, March 20, 2023 at 2:30 P.M. at the National Cemetery of the Alleghenies in Washington County, PA.

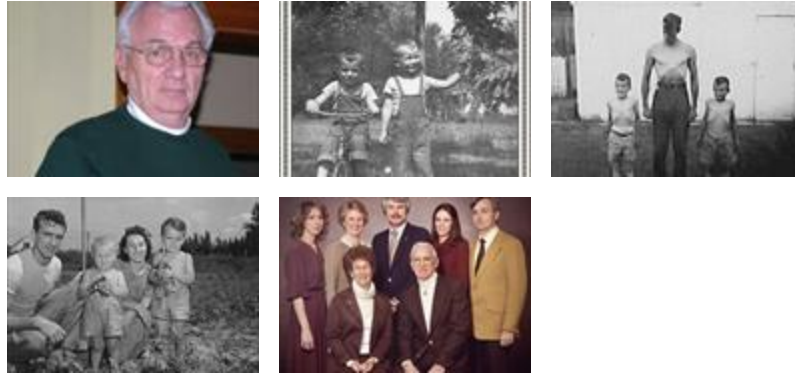
