Frank T. "Fritz" Dano, Jr., 92, of Butler, left to be with the Lord at 8:15AM on Wednesday, July 12, 2006 at the Veteran's Affairs Medical Center in Butler.

He was born Thursday, February 12, 1914 in Thomas, WV, the son of the late Frank T. Dano, Sr. and the late Julia Kocan Dano.

Mr. Dano was a decorated Army Veteran of WWII having served in the South Pacific under the command of General Douglas MacArthur. He was a member of the American Legion Post #778 for 61 years. He enjoyed gardening and was an avid golfer in his early years. He was the first senior men's club champion in 1957 at the Armco Country Club.

He retired from Armco Butler Works in 1976 as a Stainless Surface Quality Auditor under special assignment.
