Fred Leroy McKinney, 88, of Chicora, passed away Thursday, September 5, 2013 at Sunnyview Home.

He was born August 15, 1925 in Concord Twp., PA, the son of the late George S. and Anna Belle (Christie) McKinney.

Fred attended Concord Presbyterian Church. He was a Corporal of the US Army Corps of Engineers and was the Honor Guard for the 1st American killed in Korea.
