Frederick Dean Farley, 71, of Butler, PA, passed away Thursday, May 23, 2013 at UPMC Montefiore Hospital.

He was born February 12, 1942 in Marietta, OH, the son of the late Russell P. and Manota Belle (Milligan) Farley.

Dean Farley (RMSC Senior Chief) was a twenty year veteran of the U.S. Navy where he retired in Brunswick, Maine after a long, dedicated career. Dean served two tours in Vietnam and participated in the Bay of Pigs Operation. He was defined by the military code of honor, tradition, valor and his love for helping others. In addition, he served as an ambassador for veterans around Pennsylvania, Ohio and Minnesota in recent years. Dean was an entrepreneur in the business world, upon his retirement from the U.S. Navy, with a lucrative business he ran for many years in the field of government contracts out of Minnesota.
