Gary Alan Protzman, 62, of Butler, PA, passed away at 5:20 AM on Wednesday, April 28, 2010 at his residence after an illness.

He was born July 12, 1947 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Gilbert A. Protzman and the late Bernice (Morrow) Protzman.

Gary was a member of Mt. Chestnut Presbyterian Church. He loved dirt track racing and was always in the pits at Lernerville working on cars. Gary also loved hunting, playing softball and he umpired and coached little league baseball and softball at Prospect Boys Club. He had worked at Pullman Standard and then Hindman Transfer. He was a veteran of US Army during Vietnam War. He was a member of Victory Lodge 694 and the American Legion Post 119.

Surviving are his wife, Sue Ann (Bartley) Protzman whom he married December 30, 1978; his daughter, Mrs. Lance (Garrah Lynn) Neigh of Butler, 1 niece and 4 nephews, a brother in law and 2 sister in laws.

He was preceded in death by his son, Adam Jon Paul Protzman who died in an accident on January 1, 2002, his parents, and his mother and father in law.
