Guy Colosimo, 82, of Butler, PA, passed away during the early morning hours Monday, October 31, 2011 in the presence of his beloved family at Butler Memorial Hospital.

He was born October 25, 1929 in New Hope, PA, the son of the late Thomas V. and Rose (Morillo) Colosimo.

Guy graduated from West Sunbury High School in 1948 and served in the United States Army until 1953 during the Korean War. He married the love of his life, Frances Barron on November 12, 1955.
