Harriet Loretta Maxwell, 90, of Butler (Preston Dr.), went peacefully to be with her Lord on Friday, June 8, 2012 at Good Samaritan Hospice.

She was born June 4, 1922 in Wheeling, WV, the daughter of the late Charles E. and Pearl (Barrett) Porter.
