



## Harry Rorabaugh

August 11, 1924 - November 14, 2008

Harry L. Rorabaugh, 84, of Butler, PA, died at 5:45PM on Friday, November 14, 2008 at Veteran's Affairs Medical Center in Butler.

He was born Sunday, August 11, 1924 in Burnside Twp. Clearfield Co., the son of the late Glenn Rishel Rorabaugh and the late Elizabeth Fry Rorabaugh. Mr. Rorabaugh was a member of Trinity Presbyterian Church. He was a past master of Butler Lodge 272, New Castle Scottish Rite & York Rite, Knights of York Cross, and Advisor DeMolay Board. Harry was a veteran of the U.S. Army having served in WWII where he was a POW in a Nazi Prison Camp and belonged to the DAV.
