



## Irvin "Butch" G Klugh

November 13, 1917 - April 23, 2008

Irvin G. "Butch" Klugh, 90, of Butler, died at 3:45 AM on Wednesday, April 23, 2008 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

He was born Tuesday, November 13, 1917 in Butler, the son of the late Irvin M. Klugh and Vivian (Yockey) Klugh.

He was a member of St. John's Reformed Church. He had owned Klugh's Gun Shop since 1951. Butch had the oldest gun license in Butler County. From 1932 to 1970, he had worked at his father's grocery store on Cunningham Street. He had been chief deputy sheriff from 1946-1950, a special deputy from 1950-1970 and then a deputy sheriff from 1970-1982. He was a life member of the National Sheriff's Association, the Butler County Law Enforcement Association, the NRA, Masonic Victory Lodge # 694, the New Castle Consistory, Syria Shrine, Ducks Unlimited and was a 71 year member of the Odd Fellows.

Surviving are his daughter, Marilyn Klugh of Sarver; a brother, William F. Klugh of Vienna, VA; a number of nieces and nephews; his close friend & neighbor, Delores Wachsmuth.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Florence Ellen Denny Klugh whom he married July 25, 1940 and who died April 1, 2002, 3 sisters and 2 brothers. Friends will be received from 2-4 and 7-9, Thursday, April 24 at the Young Funeral Home, Ltd., Butler, PA. Services will be held at St. John's Reformed Church on Friday, April 25, 2008 at 10 AM with Rev. Robert Peterson, his pastor officiating.
