Jack C. Wagner, 76, of Butler, died at 8:08 AM on Wednesday, June 29, 2005 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

He was born September 10, 1928 in Butler, the son of the late Laverne and Grace (Haugh) Wagner.

He was a life member of the First English Lutheran Church. He was a Marine veteran, having served as a Sergeant during the Korean War. Mr. Wagner was a Purple Heart recipient. He belonged to the Bantam Marine Detachment, Lyndora American Legion, the Slovak Club, Masonic Lodge # 272, Butler County Law Enforcement Association and the VFW # 249. He was an avid hunter, fisherman and birdwatcher. He enjoyed his German shorthair pointers.
