James "Randy" Hilliard, 73, of Prospect, PA, passed away Monday, June 8, 2015 at his residence.

He was born April 16, 1942 in Butler, PA, the son of the late James Gilmore Hilliard and Margaret (Fleeger) Hilliard Barkley.

Randy was a retired insurance broker. He was a barber for 50+ years, worked as Prospect borough secretary for over 30 years, and worked as a tip staff at the courthouse for 10 years.
