Joseph P. Pasek, 86, of Port Richey, FL, formerly of Butler, died Sunday, February 19, 2006 at Hernando-Pasco Hospice Care Center in Dade City, Florida.

He was born Wednesday, July 9, 1919 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Peter Paczek and the late Pearl Buckowski Paczek.

He was a 1st officer in the Merchant Marines during WW II. He enlisted in 1942 and received an Honorable Discharge from the United States Coast Guard in August of 1945. After the war, he was a self-employed truck driver. He delivered chickens and eggs from the Butler Egg Auction to New York City and places in Connecticut. Later, he purchased a bar in Cheboygan, MI. After retirement, he moved back to Lyndora and then to Florida.

Surviving are his wife, Florence Rikal Pasek of Florida and 1 daughter, Mrs. John (Victoria) Dunn of Jacksonville, FL; 1 sister, Helen of Texas; and a number of nieces and nephews.
