Keith LaVerne Oesterling, 81, of Butler and Port Ritchey, FL, died at 11:05 PM on Friday, November 4, 2005 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

He was born Saturday, March 29, 1924 in McKees Rocks, PA, the son of the late Leland William Oesterling and the late Marcella Grabe Oesterling.
