



## LeRoy S. Kuhn

LeRoy S. Kuhn, 94, of Hooker, died Friday, January 9, 2004 at 7:10 AM at his Residence.

Born December 25, 1909 in Butler County, he was the son of William H. Kuhn and Lillian M. Sankey Kuhn.

For fifty-two years, he worked in, and eventually owned, the family business, WH Kuhn and Son, Butler County's largest country store, located on Route 38 in Hooker. He was the oldest active member of Concord Presbyterian Church, where he served as Elder and Trustee. He also was the teacher for the Men's Church School Class and served as the Church Treasurer for many years. He authored several books, including " The First 175 Years, a History of the Concord Presbyterian Church", " 130 Years History of a Country Store" and "It was Yesterday". All proceeds from these works were donated to the Easter Seal Society, now Lifesteps of Butler County, in gratitude for their assistance during his childhood bout with polio..

Surviving are several nieces and nephews.

Preceding him in death were his wife, Katharyn ( Kay) Kuhn who died July 31, 1992.

Services will be held at the Concord Presbyterian Church, Sat., Jan. 17, 2004 at 11 AM, with Rev. Robert V. Mathias officiating.
