Loy Albert Youkers Sr., 90, of Plano, TX, formerly of Butler died Monday, January 3, 2005 at Heritage Manor Health Care Center in Texas.

He was born October 16, 1914 in Knox, PA, the son of the late Rev. John J.W. Youkers and the late Mary Elizabeth (Ganoe) Youkers.

He was a member of the First English Lutheran Church where he served on the Church Council. He was a US Navy veteran of WW 2 having served at the Naval Air Station in Jacksonville, FL, in Europe and in South America. He was a member and Past Commander of American Legion Post #117 in Butler, and the 40 & 8. He was secretary of the Center Township Municipal Water Authority. He was also a licensed private pilot.

Mr. Youkers retired in 1980 from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Milk Marketing Board.
