



## Mary E. Crouch Klink Bell

Mary Elizabeth (Crouch) Klink Bell, 87, of Butler, passed away Monday, December 24, 2012 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

She was born May 9, 1925 in Clay Township, Butler County, the daughter of the late Lawrence Everett and Isabelle (Thompson) Crouch.
