Mary Bernadine (Schweppe) Hoffman, 88, of Verona, PA, formerly of Butler, died Thursday, May 3, 2007 at her residence.

She was born Friday, February 7, 1919 in Blairsville, PA, the daughter of the late Walter Schweppe former mayor of Butler in the 1950's and 1960's and the late Ethel Vogeley Schweppe.
