Michael (Mike) M. Newcaster, 85, of Butler, passed away peacefully Monday, February 17, 2025, at his home.

A lifelong resident of Butler, he was born March 20, 1939, the son of the late Nicholas and Margaret (Dorcy) Newcaster and grew up on Institute Hill. He graduated from Butler High School as part of the class of 1957.
