Norman Eugene Shimmel, 66, of Butler, PA, passed away at 10:48 PM on Friday, July 2, 2010 at Veteran's Affairs Medical Center.

He was born August 2, 1943 in Tarentum, PA, the son of the late Michael Shimmel and Clara (Green) Shimmel.

After graduating from Butler Senior High School in 1961, he served in the United States Air Force for four years at several installations both in the States and abroad as a medical technologist. After leaving the service, he worked at the University of Pittsburgh, Falk Clinic assisting in hemophilia research. Later he worked for Westinghouse Electric Corp. at their Research & Development center in Churchill. He graduated from Butler Community College with an associate's degree in mathematics in 1976. He worked for Castle Rubber Co. for 17 years as a Cost Estimator and as a manager introduced where he introduced the use of computers and mathematical modeling for doing estimates. He later worked for Custom Glass Copr in Kittanning as an estimator and inside salesman. He also worked for Armstrong Group of Companies as a computer operator in their data center. Later he worked at Butler County Community College learning center. He served as a Sr. Aide and computer consultant at teh Lighthouse Foundation. He also did similar volunteer work for newly created community Health Clinic. He had previously served as member and officer for the Butler Co. Symphony

Board of Directors. He had been a volunteer church organist. His interests included his many pets, mathematics, music and computer programming.

Surviving are 2 cousins, James Logue of Butler, PA and Kathleen Connors of Butler.

He was preceded in death by his parents.
