



Paul Baxter Hoffman

August 3, 1916 - January 3, 2011

Paul Baxter Hoffman, 94, of Verona, PA, formerly of Butler, died Monday, January 3, 2011 at his residence.

He was born Thursday, August 3, 1916 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Carl Frederick Hoffman Sr. and the late Ruth Logan Hoffman.

He was a graduate of Muskingum College and Columbia University Business School. He was President and Partner of Hoffman Auto Parts. An active member in Covenant United Presbyterian Church, he served as an Elder and Clerk of Sessions. As a Lieutenant in the US Navy, he served as a patrol bomber pilot in the Squadron VPB123 in WWII. He was a member of Victory Lodge 694, Butler Country Club and a board member of the Butler County Symphony.
