Ralph M. Logan, 85, of Butler, passed away Friday, October 23, 2015 at Sunnyview Home with his family by his side.

He was born July 3, 1930 in Pittsburgh, he was the son of the late Howard M. and Virginia (Head) Logan.

Ralph was a graduate of Butler Senior High School and attended Johnson Bible College and Slippery Rock College. He served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean War as a crew member in P2V Navy Bomber Squadron stationed in Japan and Okinawa.

In November of 1951, he married Helen M. Staaf of Butler in St. Andrews Presbyterian Church. Ralph was a Mason for over 50 years, belonging to Victory Lodge #694, Valley of New Castle Consistory, Syria Shriners of Cheswick and Syria Caravan #14. He was also a member of the local VFW #249. He attended Westminster Presbyterian Church where he was a charter member. After his loving wife and dear family, his next love was singing with the SPEBSQSA. He retired as an officer of Mellon Bank after 30 years serving offices in Butler, Bellevue, Kittanning and Lyndora.

for leaving golden dollars for tips.
