Reed Dewayne Campbell, age 87, of West Sunbury passed away Tuesday November 27, 2012 at Orchard Manor in Grove City surrounded by his loving family..

Reed was born April 8, 1925 in Butler County, PA. He was the son of the late Richard James Campbell and the late Viletta Violet Stamm Campbell.
