Richard N. White, 76, of Butler, passed away Saturday, December 12, 2020 at Butler Memorial Hospital.

He was born May 22, 1944 in Butler, the son of the late William H. and Ruth (Robinson) White.

Dickie was a 1963 Butler High graduate where he was an outstanding football player. He also sang Doo Wop in the group "The Continentals" in the early 1960's. 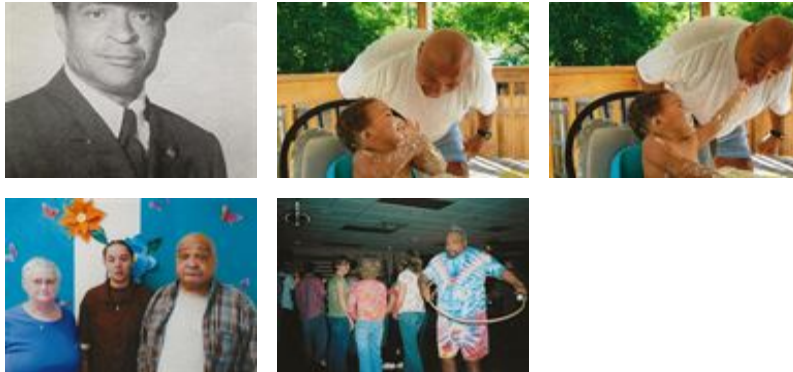
