Richard E. Dumbaugh, Sr., 86, of Butler, PA, passed away of Mesothelioma at 11:15 PM on Saturday, December 18, 2010 at Good Samaritan Hospice in Cabot, PA.

He was born February 16, 1924 in Butler, PA, the son of the late John Edward Dumbaugh and the late Eva (Griffith) Dumbaugh.

Richard was a member of St. Marks Evangelical Lutheran Church where he belonged to the Homebuilders Sunday School Class. He was in the 11th Airborne Division of the US Army during WW 2.
