Robert James Donaldson, 49, of Butler, passed away unexpectedly Friday, February 22, 2019 at his residence.

He was born May 29, 1969 in Fort Knox, KY, the son of George Donaldson and Beatrice (Willis) Donaldson of Cambridge Springs, PA.

Robert graduated Cambridge Springs High School in 1987 and then went on to study criminology at Edinboro University graduating in 1991. He was a Veteran of the US National Guard for 25 years where he was a major and retired in 2011. He made his 25 year career with the Pennsylvania State Police where he retired as a sergeant in March 2017. After his retirement he currently was a security guard for the Butler Area School District.

In addition to his parents he is also survived by his wife, Paula (Helgert) Donaldson of Butler, whom he married on September 3, 1994, two daughters, Kayla Donaldson and Taylor Donaldson both of Butler; a sister, Barbara (Dennis) Fetterman and their daughter Adrionna of Punxsutawney, mother in law, Margaret Helgert of Butler; a brother in law, Chad Helgert of Butler and his dog, Maya.

He was preceded in death by his father in law, Paul Helgert.

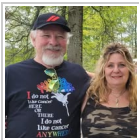

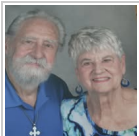
