Robert L. Protzman, 71, of Butler, PA, died at 10:40 AM on Sunday, October 3, 2004 at Clarion Hospital's Emergency Room. He had been at the family's camp in Clarion County.

He was born October 29, 1932 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Emanuel R. and Edna Mae (Lowry) Protzman.
