Ronald Joseph Novosel, 65, of Butler died on September 21, 2015.

He was born on April 21, 1950 in Kane the son of the late Joseph Novosel and Norma Hutchison Koza. Ron was raised in McMurray and was a 1968 graduate of Peters Township High school. He was a veteran of the U.S Army who served in Vietnam. He worked for years as a self-employed carpet installer and was an avid Pittsburgh Pirates fan.
