Ryan David Burgoon, 34, passed away peacefully at UPMC Presbyterian Hospital in Pittsburgh, PA, at 5:17 A.M. Monday, April 16, 2012.

Born on May 4, 1977 in Grove City, PA, he was the son of David Leo Burgoon and Kimberly Ann (Kosick) Ealy.
