Scott Dyer McKee, 65, of Butler, PA, passed away Wednesday, September 28, 2016 at his home.

He was born April 15, 1951 in Pittsburgh, PA, the son of the late Ralph Dyer and Ann Reimers McKee.

Scott was an active member of Church of the Ascension in Oakland, serving as an usher, lay reader and chalice bearer. He worked as a Human Resources Project Manager for Genco. He was a dedicated volunteer for the Kairos Prison Ministry where he was serving as the State Financial Secretary. As a leader in Kairos, Scott was also actively involved in working to bring the program to SCI Fayette and SCI Forest. Scott was an avid reader, especially of historical novels. He loved singing, cooking, travelling with his wife and family, and walking his dog at the family cabin on the Slippery Rock Creek. He was also fascinated with researching his family heritage.
