She was preceded in death by her father, Franklin Eugene McFeaters.

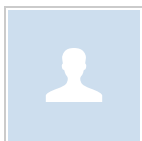

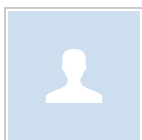

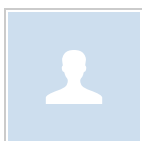
