Susan E. Gribik, 73, of Butler, passed away Monday, August 7, 2023 at Armstrong Center for Medicine & Health in Kittanning following a brief and courageous battle with cancer. Born on December 31, 1949, in Kittanning, she was the daughter of the late Henry Joseph, Sr. and Eleanor (Valliquette) Augustine. She attended Kittanning High School and Indiana University of Pennsylvania. She was employed as the office manager of her husband's medical office in Butler for over twenty-five years, both when it was owned by her husband and during the ownership of St. Francis Hospital.

Sue enjoyed boating, crocheting, playing the piano, spending time with her family and friends and Pitt basketball (but only when they were in the Big East). Although not Ukrainian by blood, she embraced the customs, food, and religion as though she was.
