She is survived by her father, John Rusidoff, her sister, Gwen Hedglin, and her niece, Amber Hedglin.

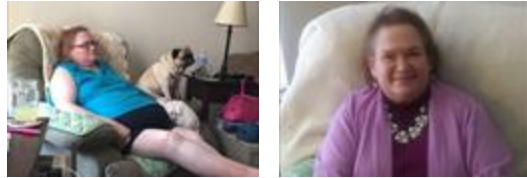
She was preceded in death by her mother, Carolyn Rusidoff.
