Terry Lee Hibbs, 63, of Butler, passed away on April 15, 2021.

Terry was born on September 10, 1957 in Butler, PA to the late Eldin O. and Alice M. (Hetrick) Hibbs.

He grew up in Meridian and graduated from Butler High School in 1975. Terry attended University of Pittsburgh School of Pharmacy and received his Bachelor of Pharmacy degree in 1981. For over 20 years, Terry served patients in the San Diego North County area through Kaiser Permanente outpatient pharmacies.

Terry was an avid traveler and a skilled photographer, exploring Australia, China, Egypt and countries in Europe. Italy was his favorite destination and his home was adorned with unique pieces collected during his travels. He was passionate about low-water landscape design and interior design, achieving a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design from the Design Institute of San Diego in 2004. He took inspiration from the work of Frank Lloyd Wright and the Arts and Crafts style.

The California lifestyle suited Terry well as he enjoyed hiking and biking and he never missed the opportunity to mention the 68 degree temperatures at Christmas.

After retirement, Terry moved back to Butler in 2016.

He is survived by two brothers, Eldin 'Mike' (Donna Lee) Hibbs and Larry (Mollie) Hibbs of Butler. He is also survived by one nephew, Michael (Kelley) Hibbs of Connoquenessing Township and two nieces, Kristin E. Hibbs of London, UK and Lauren A.
