Timothy David George, 63, of Evans City, PA, passed away at his home on Tuesday, April 29, 2014.

He was born April 7, 1951 in Kittanning, PA, the only son of the late David and Barbara (Williams) George.

Tim graduated from Worthington High School in 1969 and was a Vietnam Veteran of the U.S. Marine Corp. He was retired from BNZ Materials, Inc. in Zelienople where he had been a quality control inspector for over 20 years. He had also served as a union representative most of those years for both the Aluminum, Brick and Glass Workers Union and the Steelworkers Union. 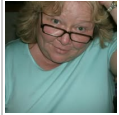
In accordance with his wishes, there will be no public viewing. A Memorial Service will be announced at a later date after his family has had time to come to terms with his unexpected loss.

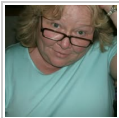
