Walter Eugene "Gene" Crouch, 73, of Bristol, TN, formerly of Butler, died at 4:45 am on Sunday, September 25, 2005 at his residence.

He was born Friday, November 6, 1931 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Joseph George Crouch and Ruth (Thompson) Crouch. He had been raised by his grandmother, Sarah Thompson.
