Walter Milich, 81, of Connoquenessing Township, completed his earthly journey at 4:55 PM on Friday, May 22, 2009 at the Butler VA Medical Center.

He was born June 9, 1927 in Butler, PA, the son of the late Rade and Mildred (Kosovic) Milich. Walter was a 1945 graduate of Butler High School and served in the US Navy from 1945 through 1946.

He attended the University of Pittsburgh and graduated with a B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering. He was also a graduate of Carnegie Mellon University's Graduate School of Industrial Administrative Science. He retired from MSA in 1987 after 35 years of service. He was a member of the United Methodist Church of Connoquenessing where he served as a Sunday school teacher and on various committees. Walter was a member of Victory Lodge # 694, where he was a Past Master. He also belonged to the Syria Temple, Shrine Luncheon Club, Butler Caravan #14, Scottish Rite of New Castle and Acacia Club. He was a member of the Meridian Area Retirement Club and was a lifetime member of the Connoquenessing Volunteer Fireman. He had been a driver for Meals on Wheels in the Connoquenessing area.
